The 29th annual CSFT was held on September 13, 2025. The children with their parents learned basic Knot Tying and Lure-ID. Also on hand was the NJ Fish & Wildlife teaching the various fish that may be caught this day from the beach. Their staff also was on the beach collecting Data on some of the fish that were caught and released. The Seaside Park Volunteer Fire Co. #1 brought out their Beach Rescue truck with the Ocean Rescue Inflatable Boat. The two firemen taught everyone the dangers of Rip Currents and Ocean Safety. Not a lot of fish were caught this year, only 9 entries were received. The biggest being a Skate that measured 32 1/2" and the smallest being a Kingfish measuring 4" and winning a donated \$50.00 Gift Card from Dick's Sporting Goods. Five Bluefish from 10" to 15 1/4" were entered along with 1 Fluke at 16 1/4" and believe it or not, an 8" Pompano. 11 Trophies along with \$25.00 gift cards and combos of 9" were given to the winners. 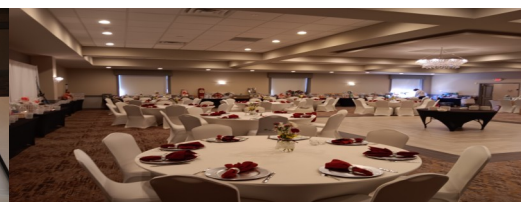
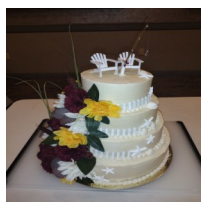

NJBBA President Mark Dzindzio and NJOA – United Conservationist Foundation, Inc. (UCF) President Tony Pensabene have entered into advanced discussions to facilitate a strategic alliance.

Our two sporting groups are already collaborating their energies seeking a focused, mutually beneficial based dialog with NJ's DEP-Parks Dept. Among multiple topics, some of which have extended for decades, the groups and Parks are currently looking to forge a new three way conservation-centric partnership specific to IBSP,s new 2026 Mobile Sport Fishing Vehicle (MSFV) permit lottery system.

The NJOA-UCF (501©4) has been established, among other things to unify New Jersey's major statewide sporting organizations and large sporting clubs to represent and speak statewide as a single voice of stakeholders, advocating for Anglers, Hunters and Trappers statewide including Trenton. All this in the name of Conservation and Environmental stewardship.

NJBBA President Mark Dzindzio was recently quoted as saying:

“The NJBBA and its 70+ years dedicated to the preservation of beach access for mobile surf fishing and the conservation of coastal and marine resources would perfectly align the NJBBA as a lead, strategic Advisory Council Organization of the newly established UCF.”

The NJBBA and the UCF are targeting first quarter 2026 to formalize their strategic alliance.

Zoom Beach Driving Class

This Spring NJBBA will again be offering the Beach Driving Clinic. This clinic was first offered at Island Beach State Park back in the 90's to help promote safe beach driving and to warn drivers of the differences of driving on soft beach sand vs normal paved roads. It then blossomed into the commission of an educational tape to help with the continuation of the information through out the year.

Because of the increased access to the drivable beaches, a second clinic was added in South Jersey in the mid 2000's, which took place in Brigantine. The In person clinics were provided for close to thirty years, but had to be moved to the ZOOM format due to COVID. In the past we had classes of about 20 attendees per clinic. With the ZOOM format, we have averaged 45 attendees which included people from New Jersey, Pennsylvania, New York and North Carolina.

The offering of this clinic has continued part of our mission to preserve beach access for all beach users. Members of NJBBA should be proud of the forty-five plus years service that we have provided to the public concerning the education of beach driving. The next clinic is tentatively set for Wednesday, April 22nd at 7:00PM.

Only NJ Saltwater Fishing size limits will qualify.

NO undersize Fluke from IBSP or Delaware Bay or **Striped Bass Bonus** tagged fish will qualify

All fish must be caught by hook and line/rod, and reel between March 1 and December 31 from the surf, bay shore, pier or jetties in New Jersey waters (no boats)

Species included are Northern Kingfish, Bluefish, Striped Bass, Weak Fish and Fluke.

There will be a 1st, 2nd and 3rd prize in each category, with \$50 for 1st, \$30 for 2nd and \$15 for 3rd. No participant may win more than one prize for each category.

Prizes will be awarded at the Annual Banquet.

Only this Affidavit or an exact facsimile will be accepted and must be postmarked within 5 days of the date the fish was caught. The affidavit must be filled out completely and if not may be cause for disqualification.

Fish must be weighed at any bait and tackle shop in the state of New Jersey.
